You give consent that the participant may be subject of a pat down search by Disney while on the premises of the Disneyland Resort. You will need your ID and receipt to get on the bus.		
You are responsible for your own food while at the event. NO outside food is permitted.		
Alcoholic beverages or any illegal substance, smoking, vaping, and electronic cigarettes are prohibited at <b>Disneyland</b> .		
Participant will adhere to dress code. Class and/or school shirt and/or sweatshirt are encouraged.		
Participant will behave in a manner that is deemed normal by civilized society. Weapons or objects that appear to be weapons are not allowed. Laser pointers or other items deemed potentially harmful or disruptive are prohibited.		
Participant must remain on Disney property at all times. Wristband must be worn at all times. If participant loses wristband, it will not be replaced, and participant will be sent home, with parent/guardian/authorized person picking up participant from the park. If participant leaves the Disney property at any time, participant will be automatically expelled and parent/guardian must immediately pick up participant from park.		
A late fee of \$20 will be charged per 15 minutes after the arrival time on June 5 <sup>th</sup> . Please make sure to arrive on time.		
Upon return from Disneyland, student <i>will be picked up on Figueroa St. between 2:30 am to 2:45am on Sunday, June 5th.</i> Please indicate how your student will be getting home? (Please check) My child will be taking a service car (Uber, Lyft, Taxi) _____; will be picked up by authorized guardian/adult _____; will drive home _____.		
Students will not be allowed to take public transportation or walk home. All students must be picked up by parent or authorized person, or drive home (either own car, Uber, Lyft or taxi). Once the student leaves the school premises in a service car (Uber, Lyft or taxi), 32 <sup>nd</sup> St. USC PTSA, California State PTA and 32 <sup>nd</sup> St. MAE High School are released of any liability incurred outside of the school premises. 32 <sup>nd</sup> St. USC PTSA, California State PTA, nor 32 <sup>nd</sup> St. MAE High School will not be responsible for any damages, theft, or loss of property on Cars parked on school premises or street.
